



3.1. Troubleshooting Guide



3.2. Trial Operation (after checking Troubleshooting Guide).

3.2.1. Assembly

- Confirm if there is no gap between housing A and B by pinching lead wires.
- There is no dust or deformation on battery terminals.

3.2.2. Operation

- Check whether the switch can be moved between the "HIGH" and "LOW" positions.
- Press the switch OFF button and verify that the unit powers off.
- Check for any abnormal sounds during tool operation.
- Check whether the dust cup can be detached and reattached smoothly.
- Check whether the dust cup suction is normal (Check whether a 1/2" ball bearing (approx. 8 g) can be picked up).


3.2.3. Integrity

- There should be no abnormal sound when shaking the unit.
- confirm if there is no dirt when repairing.


4 Disassembly and Assembly Instructions

* To assemble the tool, start with 4-6 and proceed to 4-1.

4.1. Removing the Exterior components.




4.2. Removing the Housing.




1. Remove 8 housing tapping screws and remove the housing B and the switch cover assembly.

4.3. Removing the Motor assembly and Module assembly.



- 1. Remove the motor assembly, module assembly and main switch block from the housing A.
- 2. Disconnect the main switch block's 4-pin connector.

4.4. Removing Solder Connections.




1. Remove the two soldered module assembly lead wires to the motor assembly terminals.

NOTE: (When assembling)

Solder the lead wires(red/black) to the motor assembly terminals as shown in the figure to the left.

4.5. Removing the Support rubber.




1. Remove the support rubber from the motor assembly.

NOTE: (When assembling)


Align the four protrusions on the motor assembly and support rubber.
